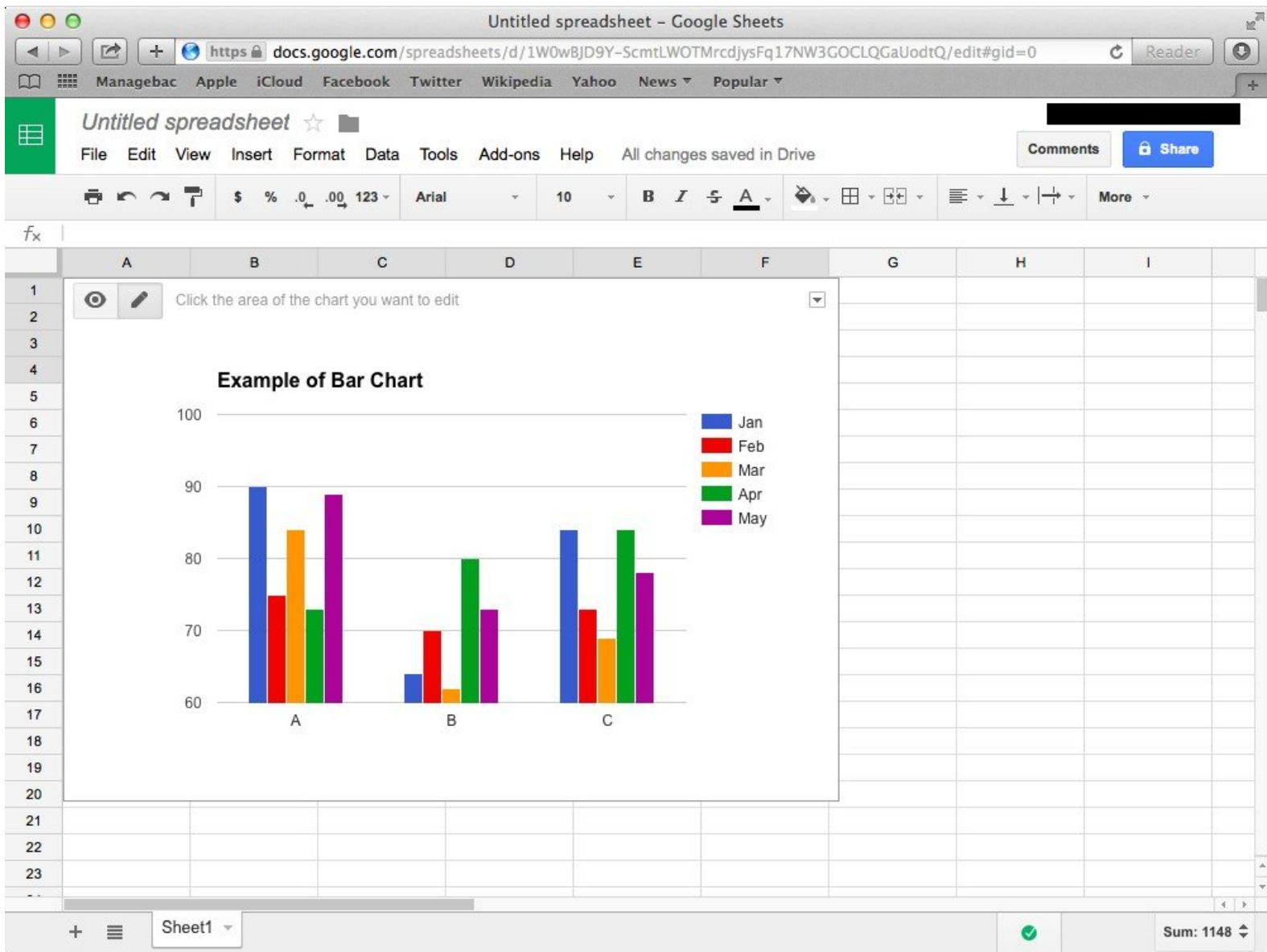

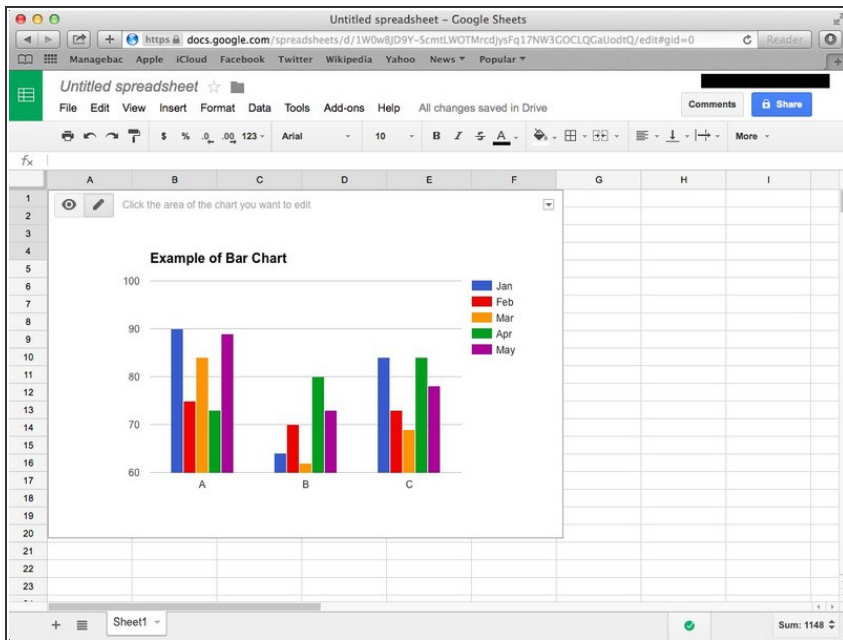

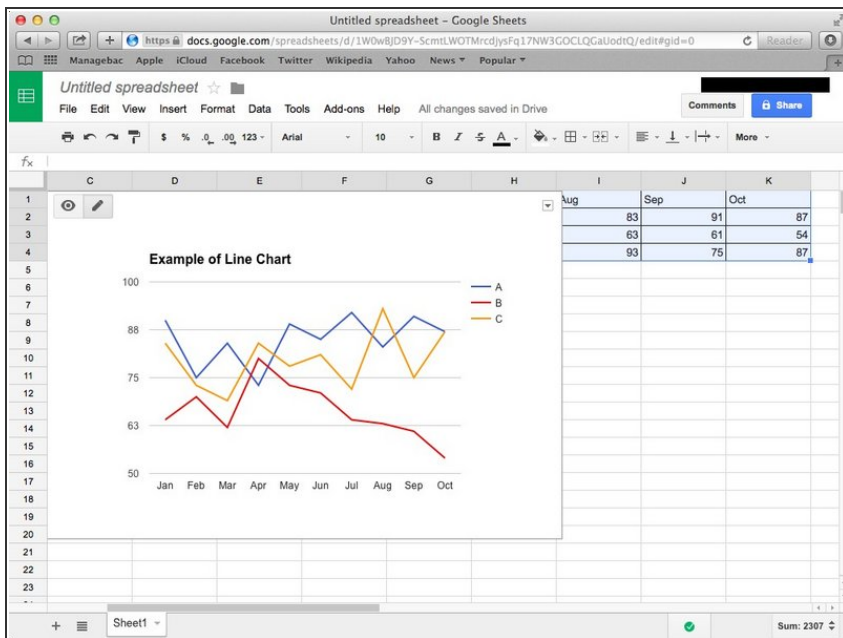
Step 1 — Bar Chart



i You use it when you are comparing more than 2 variables with same units. And when you want to show data changes over a period of time. Also when you want to show the maximum and minimum value.

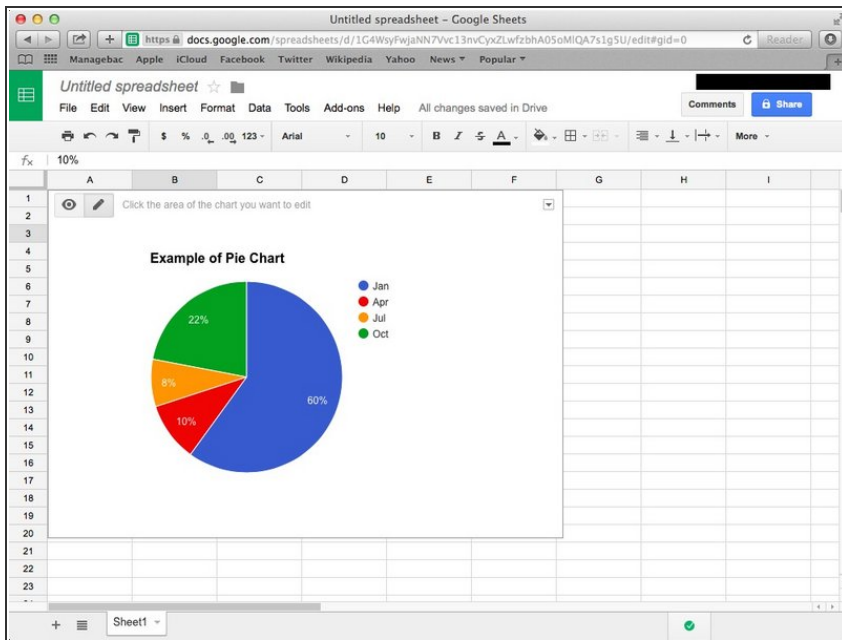
Step 2 — Line Chart



i Line Chart is used when you want to show data trends over long period of time. If the number of categories were more than 8. And when you have too many data points to plot and bar chart clutter the data. Also it's useful to show how much does it changed over a period of time.

Step 3 — Pie Chart



i You use pie chart when you want to show breakdown of the data. If you have only 1 series of data. When you have less than 5 points to plot. And when the data points represent the part of whole pie. Also when the constituents are of comparable size.
