## Step 1 - How to Access google.com



- Typing "google.com" in the address bar to go to the google website

## Step 6 - Creating a New Spreadsheet



- Click + button to create new spreadsheet


## Step 7 - Using The + Operation



## - Type "=SUM(A1+B1)" to apply the +

 operation
## Step 8 - Using The - Operation



- Type in any box "=SUM(A1-B1)" to apply the - operation on the two or more cells you selected


## Step 9 - Using The * Operation



## - Type in any cell "=SUM(A1*B1)" to apply the * operation

## Step 10 - Using the / Operation



- "Type in any cell "=SUM(A1/B1)" to apply the / operation
