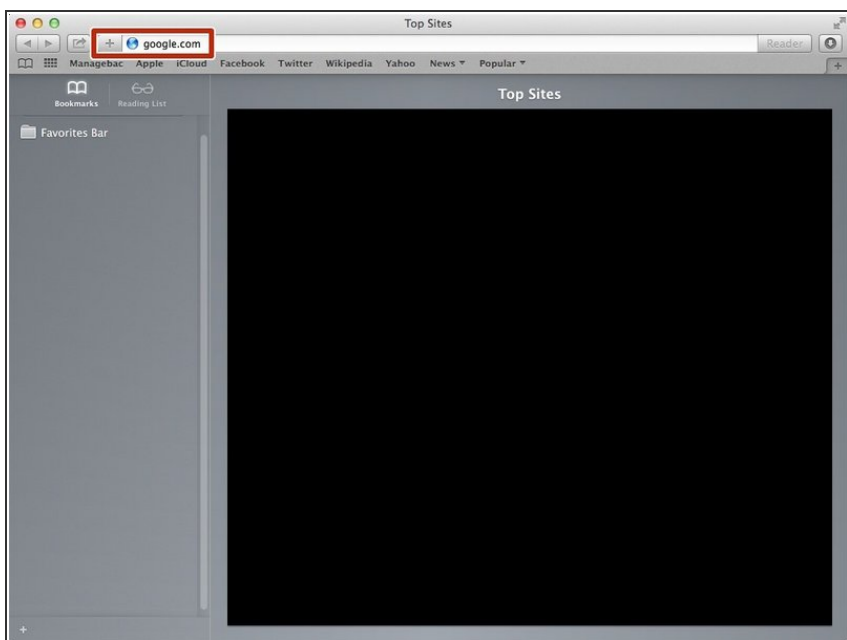

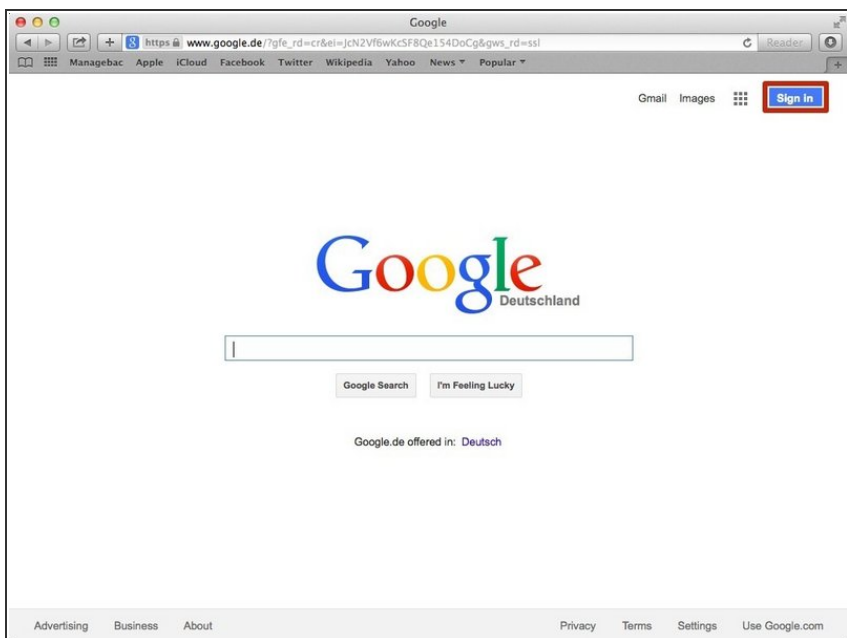

Step 1 — How to Access google.com



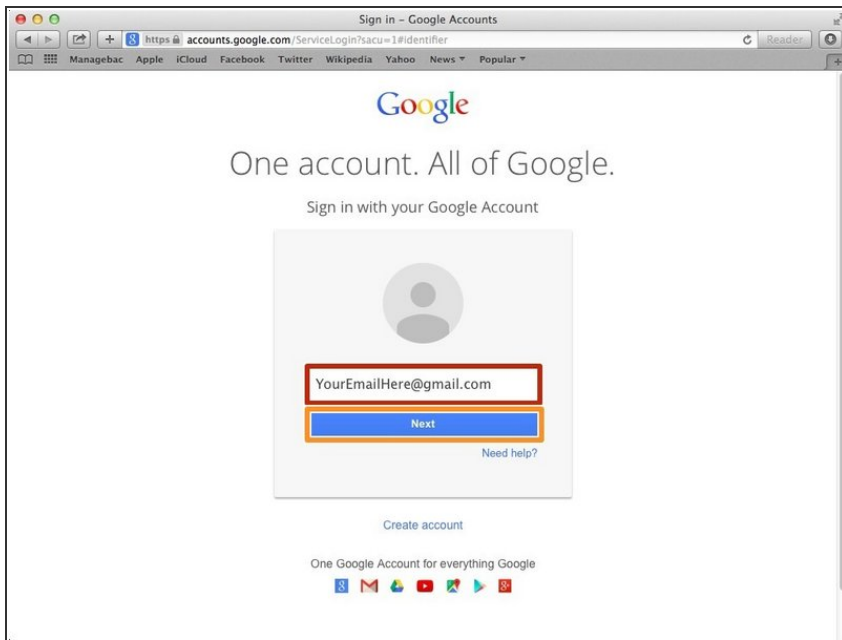
- Typing "google.com" in the address bar to go to the google website

Step 2 — Finding The Sign In Button



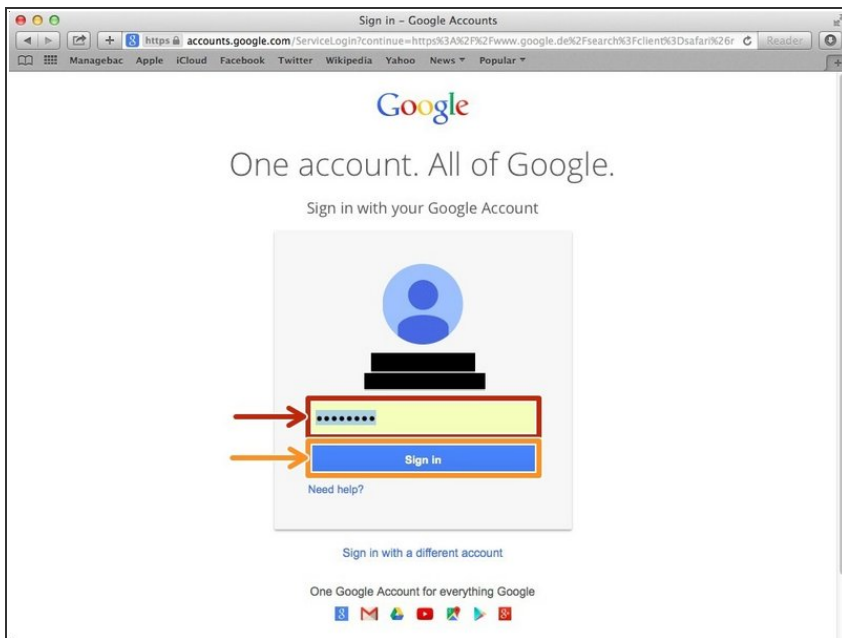
- Click on the "Sign In" button to sign in your google account

Step 3 — Entering Your Email



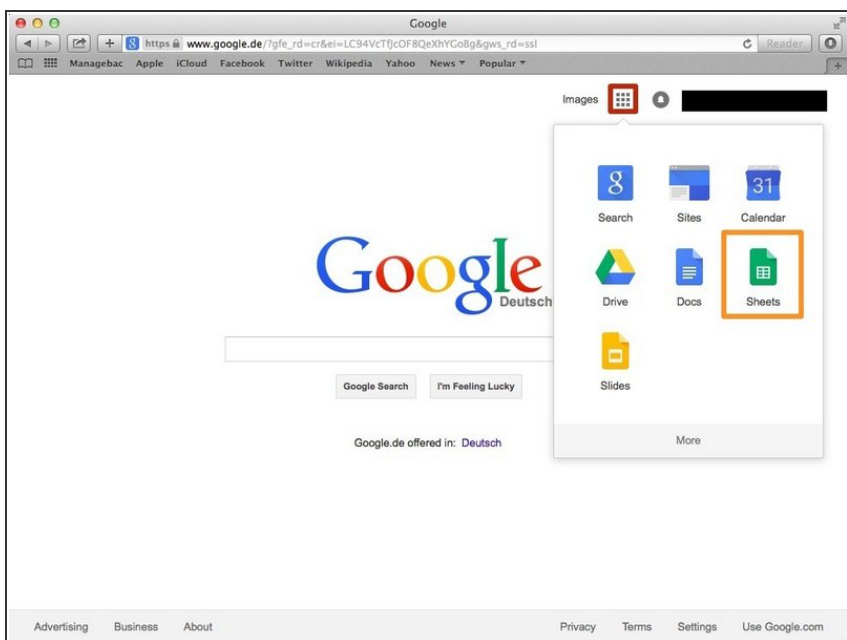
- Type your email address into this box

Step 4 — Entering In Your Password



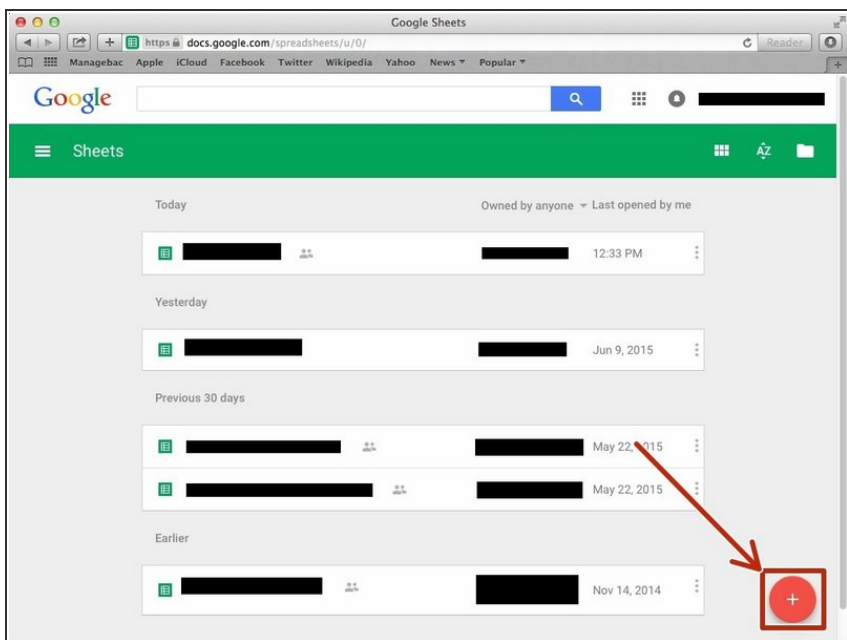
- Type your password into this box

Step 5 — Opening Google Sheet



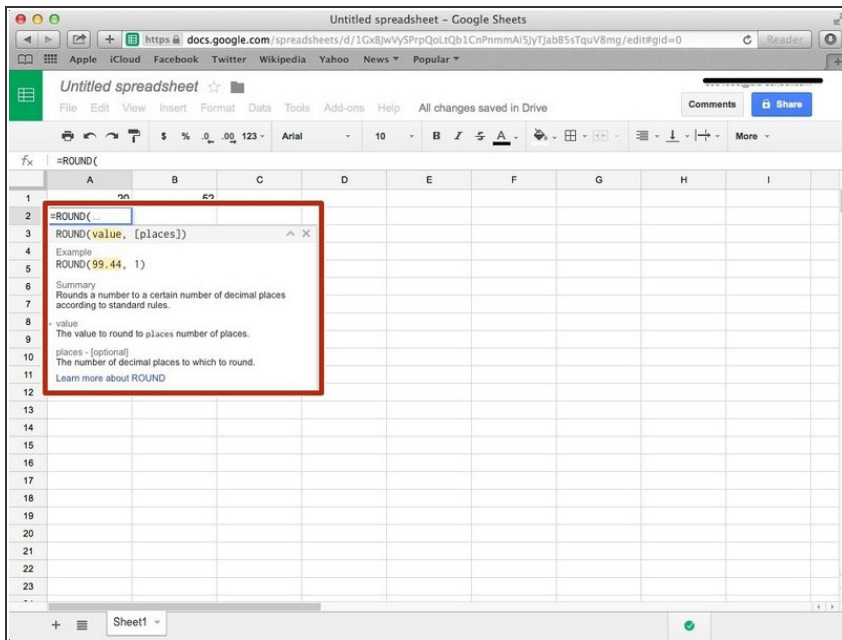
- Click this button to open a menu of options
- Click on the "Sheet" button

Step 6 — Creating a New Spreadsheet



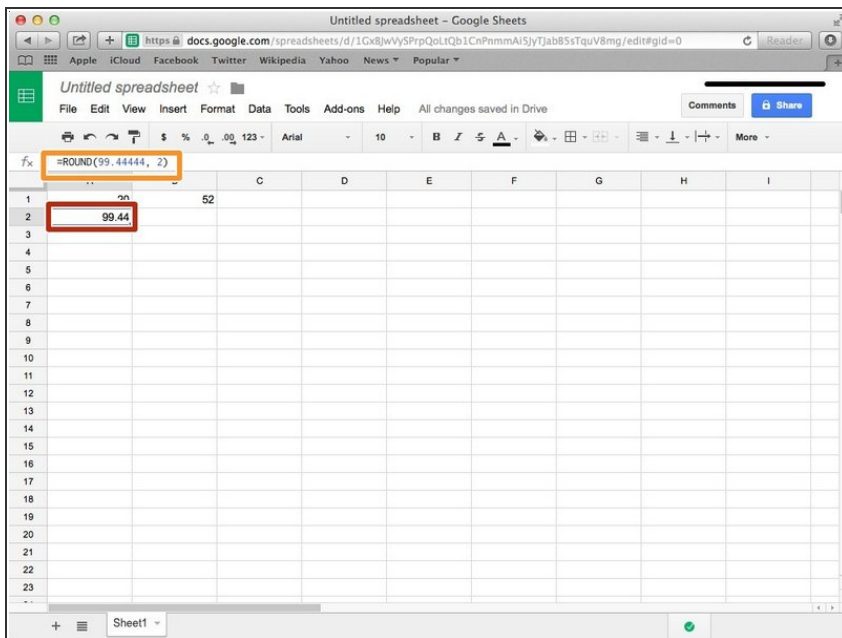
- Click + button to create new spreadsheet

Step 7 — Rounding Numbers



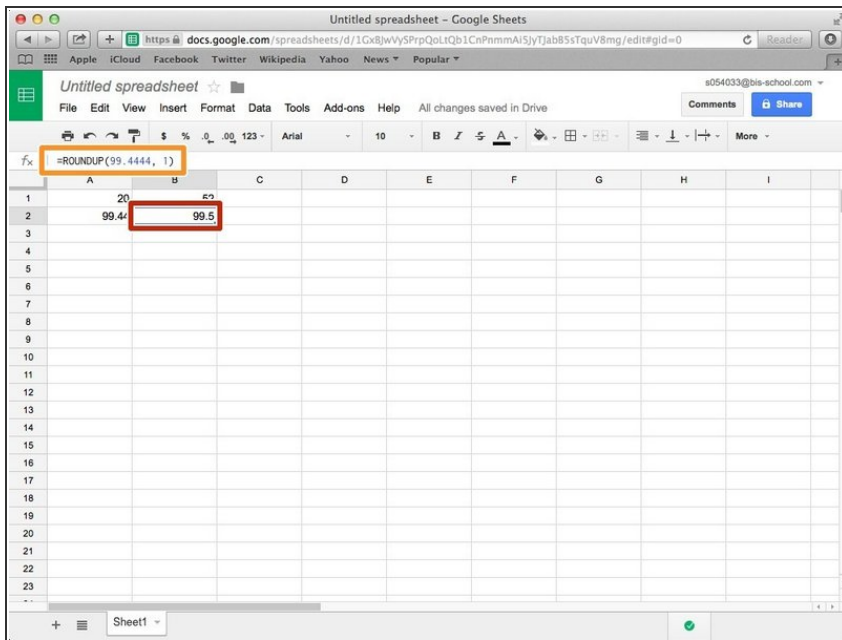
- Type in a cell "`=ROUND(Value, [places])`".

Step 8 — Rounding Numbers



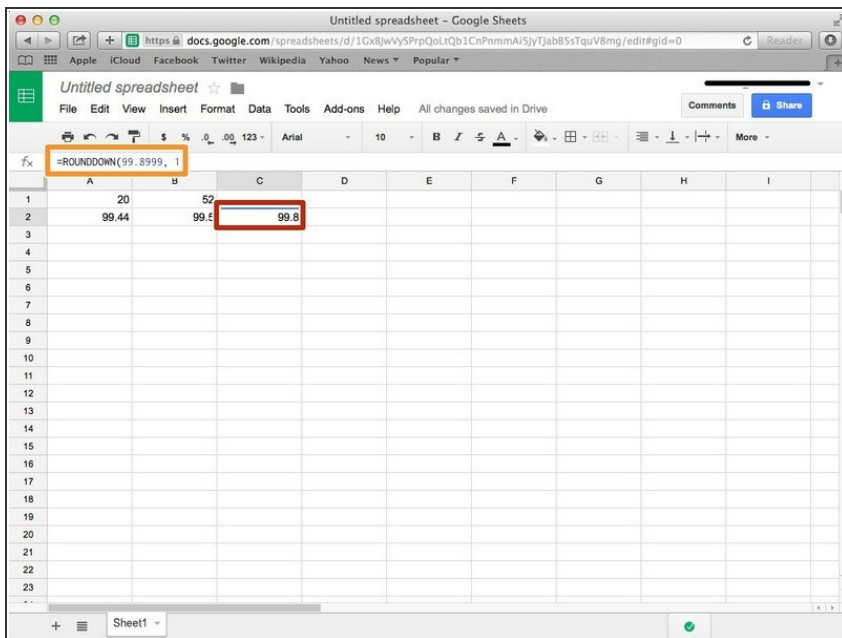
- Here is the rounded number
- Here is the formula `=ROUND(Value, [places])` with numbers substituted in (`=ROUND(99.44444, 2)`)

Step 9 — Rounding A Number Up



- Here is the rounded number
- Here is the formula `=ROUNDUP(Value, [places])` with numbers substituted in (`=ROUNDUP(99.44444, 1)`)

Step 10 — Rounding A Number Down



- Here is the number that needs to be rounded
- Here is the formula `=ROUNDDOWN(Value, [places])` with numbers substituted in (`=ROUNDDOWN(99.44444, 1)`)
