- Type in a cell "=ROUND(Value, [places])".
(i) Summary Rounds a number to a certain number of decimal places according to standard rules. value The value to round to places number of places. places - [optional] The number of decimal places to which to round.

Here is the formula =ROUNDUP( Value, [places]) with numbers substituted in (=ROUNDUP $(99.44444,1)$ )

## Step 10 - Rounding A Number Down



- Here is the number that needs to be rounded

Here is the formula =ROUNDDOWN( Value, [places]) with numbers substituted in (=ROUNDDOWN(99.44444, 1))
